Pancreatic Cancer: By the Numbers

- the rate is 15.7%
- The 5-year survival rate is about 10%
- Most people are diagnosed at a later stage of the disease
- The most effective treatment is surgical removal, but most patients are diagnosed at a too advanced stage
- At this time, there is no easy screening test for pancreatic cancer

• About 60,000 people are diagnosed with pancreatic cancer each year in the US • The average rate of occurrence in the US is 12.9% but in the Black community

- Pain in the abdomen or back
- Pain after eating
- Indigestion
- Nausea

- Unintended weight loss
- Fatigue

Most Common Symptoms

- pain in the abdomen or back
- pain after eating
- indigestion
- nausea
- loss of appetite
- unintended weight loss
- fatigue
- dark urine
- light-colored stool
- jaundice



Less Common Symptoms

- New-onset diabetes after age 50
- Sudden onset depression
- Acute pancreatitis
- Blood clots
- Odd fatty deposits under the skin



- Itching
- Rapid weight loss
- Jaundice
